Powerboat and Safety Boat Courses

6th & 13th March: Powerboat Level 2
20th & 27th March: Powerboat Level 2
2nd & 3rd April: Safety Boat
7th & 14th August: Powerboat or
Safety Boat, depending on demand

Powerboat: provides a **practical** introduction to boat handling, seamanship and safety in powerboats. It is suitable for those who have no previous experience, or who require the RYA Certificate. The sessions include:

Launch & recovery	Anchoring
Boat preparation	Leaving & coming alongside
Boat handling	Being towed
Picking up & securing to a mooring buoy	Man overboard

Safety Boat: introduces the techniques used to provide safety and rescue cover, and to assist in race management. The practical sessions include:

Boat preparation	Windsurfer rescue
Boat handling	Towing
Dinghy rescue	End-of-day procedures

There is also a shorebased theory component.

*You **must** have an RYA Level 2 Powerboat certificate and some practical experience before undertaking a Safety Boat course. It is strongly recommended that rescue crew hold a First Aid certificate.*
