

2010 Duties

Dutyman is now open for you to select which duties you wish to do this year.

If you do not select the dates you require, dates will be issued to you when the duty roster is composed at the beginning of March.

If you are unable to make the dates you choose or have been issued to you, it is up to you to swap them.

Each member is committed to do 2 race administration duties a year i.e. Sunday racing or Open meetings, (if you wish to do more, or a Wednesday night, no one will complain). If your partner doesn't sail, remember to tick the appropriate box on the renewal form, so they are not issued a duty

To volunteer for a duty on Dutyman

From the club website www.banburysailing.org.uk click on the link to DutyMan (top right).

Type in your password.

If you have forgotten your ID or password click on 'Don't know name or password' and follow the instructions on screen.

Click on Calendar view (1) then the Volunteer tab (2)
