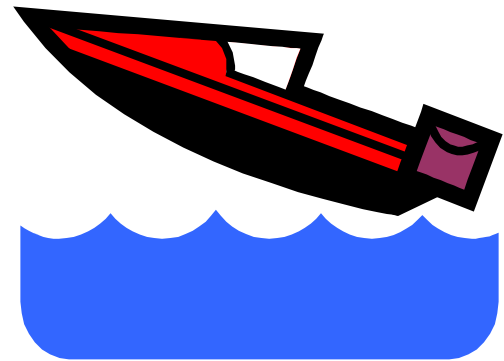




Power Boat Course (RYA Level 2)

This course, comprising one evening session and one Saturday, provides a **practical** introduction to boat handling, seamanship and safety in powerboats. It is suitable for those who have no previous experience, or who require the RYA Certificate. The practical sessions include:

- Launch & recovery
- Boat preparation
- Boat handling
- Picking up & securing to a mooring buoy
- Anchoring
- Leaving & coming alongside
- Being towed
- Man overboard

There is also a shorebased element to the course.

Bring a packed lunch. Tea/coffee will be available all day/evening.

Places are limited. There will be a further course in October. A nominal non-refundable charge of £20 is made to help defray expenses and the cost of the Start Powerboating handbook and the Powerboat Logbook.
