## Safety Boat Refresher

A purely practical day on the water practising rescuing people (first) and dinghies (later) from the Club's fleet of powerboats.

To get the most out of this day you must have reasonable powerboat handling skills. Good slow speed manoeuvring is essential. But even if you have never used a powerboat you'll get something out of this course. All safety boats need a crew, and if they know what they are doing rescues are easier and safer.

It is strongly recommended that rescue crew hold a First Aid certificate.

Bring a packed lunch. Tea/coffee will be available all day. A nominal non-refundable charge of £5 will be made to help defray expenses. Places on the course are limited.
