Jobs will be selected from this impressive (but not exclusive) list:

- Clean Clubhouse & RCB windows inside and outside
- Replace broken windows in Ladies and Gents changing rooms
- Re-hang main entrance door
- Remove cupboard in bar
- Run wiring and fit new ip cameras
- Tree planting and hedge trimming
- Tidy up any fallen trees
- Clear undergrowth along access road and trim back trees from telephone cable
- Repairs to access road
- Identify boats that should be moved to quarantine area
- Strim weeds in boat-park and along waters edge
- Repairs to clubhouse roof – carpark side of clubhouse
- Replace speed limit signs
- Tidy up storage areas:
  - Buoyancy aid store
  - Containers
  - Topper Store
  - Store under race control
- Repairs to pontoon fenders
- Repairs to Clubhouse ceiling and redecorating
- Clean algal growth from signs (entrance gate, exterior of clubhouse)
- Treat exterior wooden benches with anti-algae solution
- Repair sandpit cover
- Repaint bar store & RCB where green paint has flaked off
- Pressure wash pontoons
- Repair goose gates
- ...
